

Olin Student Health Center Same Day Urgent Clinic

- a. A required two 4-week block rotation. This rotation usually takes place in the PGY-4 year or for residents who will do the child and adolescent psychiatry fellowship this is a PGY-2 or 3 rotation. This rotation consists of three afternoon clinics per week at the Olin Student Health Center at MSU.
- b. Faculty includes MSU/Olin full-time and part-time psychiatrists. There is also a social worker on site for consultation when needed.
- c. Residents spend 5 hours in seminars and case conferences at MSU. Olin psychiatrists covering the urgent clinic are available on site.
- d. The clinical population consists of Michigan State University students. MSU has over 46,000 students, including under graduate, graduate, medical students, law students and international students.
- e. An average caseload would consist of 3-5 patients per afternoon.
- f. Residents continue to have 2 hours of weekly individual supervision with their psychiatry supervisors outside of the rotation. They see patients Monday, Wednesday and Friday afternoons with the Olin psychiatrists on staff.
- g. This clinic serves the needs of the student population at MSU and provides urgent psychiatric consultation and crisis intervention.
